All courses must be taken in the English Department except with Chair's permission. Language - Choose from Spoken A100, A101, A200, A201 or Classical A100, A101, A250, A251-A499. Students are not required to take languages above the A201 level. If a student is placed into the A201 level, 3 crs will be moved from Language to General Elective. ENGL-A205 is required of all English majors, regardless of AP or other credit by examination or of transfer credits equivalent to ENGL-T122. Students changing their majors to ENGL who have already taken T122 are still required to take A205. All such credits for ENGL-T122 will be counted as general elective credit for ENGL majors.
